June begins the first month tuition for the 2008-2009 is due. Your first payment is due on the 25th of June and is late on July 1. Please avoid a \$45 late fee by paying before July 1. We offer several convenient ways to pay. They include:

- ◆ Pay in full and get an additional 4% discount
- ◆ Pay for half of the year and get a 2% discount
- ◆ Use your credit card (Visa or MasterCard)
- ◆ Sign up for 'Simply-Giving', which automatically transfers a monthly payment to our account, allowing you to never again pay a late fee!

Mrs. Banke, our new Office Manager, will contact everyone who has signed up for monthly payments via US mail.

READ, READ, READ

Summer is here and there seems to be extra time for children to watch TV, play video games, and surf the web. During this time of the year the best thing that you can do for your child to keep their mind engaged and strong is to have them read. Take time to go to the library or your favorite bookstore and get them books.
